Mr. Provopoulos holds a Bachelor degree in Economics from the University of Athens, and a Master of Arts and PhD in Economics from the University of Essex. He has been an Associate Professor at the University of Athens from 1979 to 2007, a Vice Governor at the Bank of Greece from 1990-1993 and held various top executive positions in commercial banks from 1994 to 2008 (Economic Adviser at Alpha Bank, CEO at Emporiki Bank, Vice Chairman and Managing Director at Piraeus Bank), before becoming Governor of the Bank of Greece in June 2008 until June 2014. In the latter capacity, he was also a member of the Governing Council of the ECB, BIS and Alternate Governor for Greece in the IMF.
